<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>ADM:</b> David reiterated that all of the ADM materials had been forwarded to the Area Director for the final Secretariat processing and "Approval to Publish" polls, but the Area Director sent his Resolution to email addresses that did not include the CCSDS Document Editor. When David inquired about status, he learned that the CCSDS Editor had not seen the document, and thus no final edits have been made, and no polls have been opened. Consequently, there will be an additional delay in publishing the ADM. At this point, we are hopeful that the CESC and CMC Approval to Publish polls will commence soon.
