<b>0. Confirm Minutes of Fall Minutes</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>David sought to confirm the minutes of the Fall Meetings so they could be finalized. Alain requested some additional time to review the minutes.</li> </ul>	To Alain, and others who have not yet reviewed: Review the Fall Meeting Minutes & respond to David.
<b>1-3. Document Statuses</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The status of selected documents in progress was reviewed. Documents are sorted below in alphabetical order.</li> </ul>	To David: Report "simple" doc status to MOIMS AD.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>ADM:</b> Until recently we presumed that the ADM publication should occur before year's end. However, the CESG "Approval to Publish" poll ended with Conditions, and the Area Director who raised the Conditions has not responded to the proposed resolutions. Thus, the ADM is in limbo until perhaps early January 2024. After the CESG Poll conditions are eventually satisfied, there will be a CMC "Approval to Publish" poll.</li> </ul>	To David: Follow up with CESG regarding Poll Conditions. To Secretariat: Initiate CMC Poll once CESG Poll Conditions are satisfied.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>CDM:</b> Brian recently distributed the CDM P-1.0.7 draft based on the technical/proofreading review of P-1.0.6. David submitted the required materials to the MOIMS Area Director for the Resolution required to commence Secretariat document processing and Agency Review. David noted that historically once a standard is out of the hands of the Working Group, it is generally about a year until it is published. Dan indicated that he and Brian had provided the document to the GSFC CARA for and USSF 18th Squadron for their review and commentary. David noted that we would treat their input as "internal RIDs" once the Agency Review formally starts. As part of one CDM-related Action Item, David inquired whether or not a full internal proofread of CDM P-1.0.7 was necessary; he proposed that it was not necessary. Dan suggested that a review of just the new technical material in P-1.0.7 should be reviewed.</li> </ul>	To Brian and Dan: Retain feedback from NASA/CARA and USSF 18th until Agency Review starts, then enter RIDs.  To David: Commence CDM P-1.0.7 internal review of new technical material.

Subsequent to the meeting he followed up with the CCSDS Technical Support, which indicated that they had held the poll request thinking that they would bundle it with other polls. The ADM V.2 schemas and V.4 utility schemas (master, namespace, common) have been posted on the nav.sanaregistry.org site, and are ready to be moved to Production concurrent with the ADM V.2 publication.	To David: Complete NDM/XML Version 4 Pink Book 3.0.1.
