1. Recent News Updates & Developments	Action	
 David reported several news updates and developments: "Final" minutes of the Spring 2025 meetings have been distributed and posted on the NavWG CWE. If you should find something wrong, please advise and a revision can be produced. Patrick solved the mystery of the "relative language" question posed in the draft minutes of Spring Meetings it related to the presence of explicit references to a version of the CDM that appeared in the SANA Registry "Orbit-Relative Reference Frames"; these references have been removed from the SANA page. Thanks Patrick! The effort to remove the NHM (Navigation Hardware Message) from the "ICPS wish list", a list of standards desired by the IOAG, is finally complete. The functionality is now in ACM. David had tried for 3+ years to get the NHM off the IOAG list. The SANA "Orbital Elements" entry "KEPLERIANMEANSGP-4" requested by Cheryl has been added. A solution to the "broken URLs" problem with CCSDS Blue Books has been discussed with CCSDS Tech Support, and a solution proposed by them is under consideration. David, Dan, and Frank met with members of the IEEE Standards Association P1964 Working Group to discuss their plans for a "Standard for Collaborative Orbital Data Sharing", https://standards.ieee.org/ieee/1964/11979/. We made the case that based on the proposed name, such a standard already exists and gave a very thorough one-hour introduction to CCSDS, the Nav WG, the SANA Registry, etc. David has requested an address for the Spring Meetings location, since one has not been provided previously, making travel and hotel plans difficult.
